### May is Bike, Walk and Roll to School Month

- Get ready to bike, walk and roll to school during May. On **Wednesday, May 1** Girl Scout Troop 46140 is sponsoring a **helmet and bike equipment check from 7:30-7:55am** on the front lawn of the school. Wear your helmet and ride your bike to school for a safety check.
- Then on the first four Fridays in May (May 3, 10, 17 and 24) the troop invites students to bike, walk, or roll to school. Come to a table on the front lawn to pick up a passport book and get it stamped to earn a prize. The more stamps collected, the better the prize.
- If your child typically arrives by car, park a few blocks away from school and walk to count as participation. If your child typically takes the bus to school, that counts too. Your participation improves safety around the school and helps the earth by using less gas.

The SBA and WCAS (5<sup>th</sup> only) are administered annually to our 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> graders as a measure of their cumulative progress toward learning standard mastery. The assessments are computer based and untimed.

To support your child on testing days, we recommend adequate sleep, nutrition, and hydration. If your schedule conflicts with a testing time, reach out to your child's teacher, and find another time that works for you. Our assessment window has some flexibility through early June.
