#### Bike, Walk and Roll to School in May

During the month of May Girl Scout Troop 46140 is inviting students and parents to **bike**, **walk**, **or roll** 



to school. For the first four Fridays in May (May 3, 10, 17 and 24), students who bike, walk, or roll to school should check in at

the table on the front lawn of the school to pick up a passport book and get it stamped to earn a prize. The more stamps collected, the better the prize. By participating you're improving safety around the school and helping the earth by using less gas.

If your child typically arrives by car, park a few blocks away from school and walk in which will count as participation. If your child typically takes the bus to school, that counts too.

In addition to the Friday events, the troop is sponsoring a helmet and bike equipment check on Wednesday, May 1 from 7:30-7:55am. Wear your helmet and ride your bike that day to school for a safety check.
